RULES & GUIDELINES

CHECK IN DEADLINE: 7:45 a.m. STARTING TIME: 9:00 a.m.

RIDING QUALIFICATIONS

- Riders must be experienced and qualified.
 - Riding qualifications will be conducted by the Parade Coordinator by appointment.
 - Riders already trial qualified and riding consecutive years with KKDCP, need not repeat required trial qualifications.
 - Any rider inactive for more than two years must be re-qualified.
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PA'U UNIT

A Pa'u Queen from Hawaii Island is chosen. Eight Pa'u princesses will also be chosen to represent the (8) eight Hawaiian Islands. The Pa'u Queen's unit consists of riders to include: (1) Banner page, (1) Pa'u queen, plus male & female attendants as deemed appropriate (6 to 20 total). Each Pa'u island unit consists of (6) riders total. (1) Banner page, (1) Pa'u Princess, (2) female attendants, (2) male outriders.

WHO MAY APPLY: Princess: Must be part Hawaiian and be age 18 or older
Attendants & Outriders: Must be age 18 or older
Banner Page: Age 12 or older based on riding experience

PROOF OF AGE: Government-issued photo ID (driver's license, passport, etc.) of each rider must accompany each completed pa'u application.

WHAT TO PROVIDE: Each wahine pa'u rider must furnish (6) six kukui nuts and (2) medium safety pins and bring them to the dressing area the morning of the parade.

MEETINGS: Every effort should be made to attend all meetings called by the Pa'u Committee. These meetings are scheduled to maintain an open line of communication among all units. If you cannot attend, you must complete a "Waiver of Appearance and Substitution" form. Your unit must be represented at all meetings to keep abreast of any updates. If you are repeatedly absent from meetings without good cause, steps may be taken to remove your unit from the parade.

WAIVERS: An applicable KKDCP waiver form must be submitted for each applicant:
Horse owner liability waiver & Pa'u participant liability waiver

DUTIES OF THE PRINCESS:

- The princess is the unit leader and coordinator. She, together with the other members of the unit, are to work together to decide on the flowers, style of lei, how they are to be worn, and other materials needed.
 - The princess assigns workloads equally among the unit members and provides a suitable area to work.
 - The princess is responsible for maintaining communication between her unit and the parade committee.
 - The princess shall inform the parade committee of the progress or problems in the unit to include unit member(s) non-cooperation with assignments or responsibilities. This person(s) may be replaced at the discretion of the pa'u committee.
 - The princess shall create fellowship and goodwill within her unit.
 - The princess must provide a written narration submitted to KamehamehaDayParade@hawaii.rr.com by May 31.
 - The princess is responsible for submitting ALL completed applications and waivers for each member of her unit. Any incomplete applications will be cause for replacement of the applicant.
 - No pregnant riders are permitted to ride in the pa'u unit. Any rider(s) found in violation of this rule will risk the disqualification of the entire unit and immediate removal from the parade. This will also be cause for non-acceptance in future parade events.
