

King Kamehameha Day Celebration Day Parade

RULES & GUIDELINES

CHECK IN DEADLINE: 7:45 a.m. STARTING TIME: 9:00 a.m.

PARADE ROUTE: Parade starts at the Makaeo Events Pavilion at the Old Airport Park and ends at the Royal Kona Resort.

- Inappropriate language and gestures will not be tolerated and may result in immediate disqualification and removal by the parade marshal.
- Amplified music must be at a pleasing volume.
- Minors must have their parents/guardian sign a waiver prior to the parade.
- Each child age 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult, in a one to one ratio.
- Every 10 children between the ages of 8-17 years, must be accompanied by an adult, in a 10 to 1 ratio.
- Banners must not exceed 13 ft. in height for safety reasons.
- Throwing of candies or any items is not permitted.
- The release of any type of balloon is not permitted.
- Solicitation of any kind is not permitted.
- Do not re-enter the parade route when your entry has reached the end of the parade.

FLOATS & DECORATED VEHICLES

- Only authorized motor vehicles, trailers, etc. and licensed drivers will be allowed in the parade. For safety precautions, no acrobatic maneuvers or loud sounds by motor vehicles will be allowed during the parade.
- Height of entry must not exceed 13 ft.
- 50% of entry must be decorated with flowers and/or foliage.
- Must reflect theme of the Parade.

MOUNTED EQUESTRIAN UNIT

- Riders must be experienced and qualified.
- Riding qualifications will be conducted by the Parade Coordinator by appointment.
- Riders already trial qualified and riding consecutive years with KKDCP, need not repeat required trial qualifications.
- Any rider inactive for more than two years must be re-qualified.

WALKING/MARCHING UNITS

- Must demonstrate theme of the Parade.
